

## Guidelines for contributors

ALL publishes scientific articles, discussion papers and critical reviews. Submissions should be written in Lithuanian, Latvian, english, german, french, or russian. Submissions in other languages can be accepted upon consultation with the editors only.

The length of an article should not exceed 40,000 characters, that of a discussion paper 10,000 characters and that of a review 20,000 characters. Longer works will be published only by consent of the editor and the editorial board.

Articles should be submitted in two formats: Microsoft Word and adobe Pdf. It is requested to use Ms WinWord 2000 or later versions, using the \*.doc or \*.rtf format. The main body of the text should be typed in standard unicode fonts. Illustrations of not less than 300 dpi resolution should be presented in a separate file.

The first page of a submission should contain the full name and surname of the author, the author's affiliation, the main topics of the author's scientific research, an abstract (up to 200 words) and 5 keywords in english. Date of the submission, postal address of the author's institution or home and e-mail address should be added on the last page. The final version of the article should be accompanied by a summary in english, which will be translated into Lithuanian by the editorial staff. Summaries are not necessary for reviews and discussion papers.

Literature cited in the text should be given in brackets: author's name, year of publication, colon, page number(s), e.g., (Ambrazas 2006: 182; Žilinskienė 2002: 174). The title of collective works should be abbreviated. At the end of the article a bibliography should be given, e.g.,

Ambrazas Vytautas 2006: *Lietuvių kalbos istorinė sintaksė*. Vilnius: Lietuvių kalbos institutas.

Žilinskienė Vida 2002: Gramatinių formų vartojimas lietuvių kalbos moksliniame stiliuje. – *Acta Linguistica Lithuanica* 46, 173–178.

Linguistic forms cited in the text should be given in italics.

All submissions will be peer reviewed by two reviewers chosen by the editorial board.
